

Dr. Wulf-Dietrich Leber
Curriculum vitae
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Dr. Wulf-Dietrich Leber is Head of the hospital division at the National Association of Statutory Health Insurance Funds (GKV-Spitzenverband) in Berlin since 2008. He studied economics in Aachen and Kiel. He holds a PHD from the university of Hannover. His PHD analyzed principles of a risk structure compensation scheme for the German health insurance market. Between 1987 and 1990 he worked for the national Council of Experts for health care (Sachverständigenrat für die konzertierte Aktion im Gesundheitswesen). In the course of the German reunification Wulf-Dietrich Leber held positions as the head of the liaison office of the Federal Association of the AOK in Berlin and in Magdeburg as head of the strategy department. In 1996/97 he was responsible for designing the GP/family doctor's model of the AOK and developed Disease Management programs as well as physician networks. Between 1998 and 2004 he led the department hospital services and rehabilitation and from 2004 to 2008 the division "Health" at the Federal Association of the AOK.
